

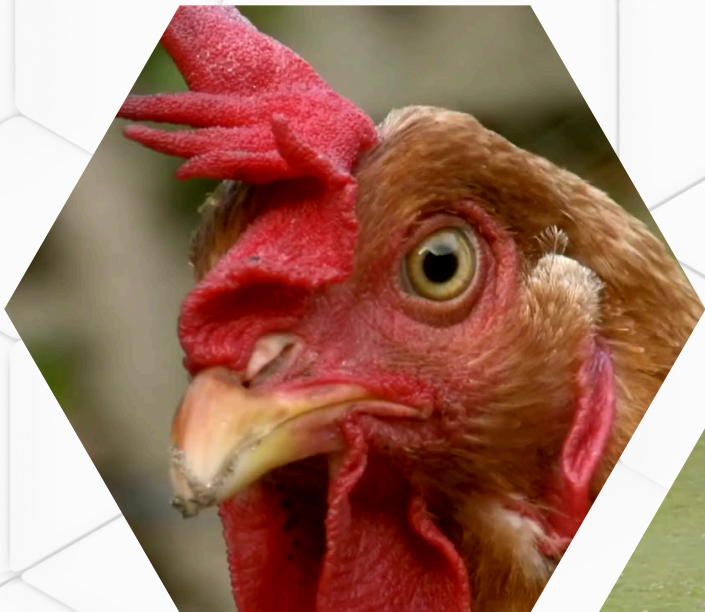

AMU/AMR Network

Aquatic Network

- MSX and Dermo in oysters in Atlantic Canada and QC, including provincial response strategies
- HPAI in marine mammals



Beef Network

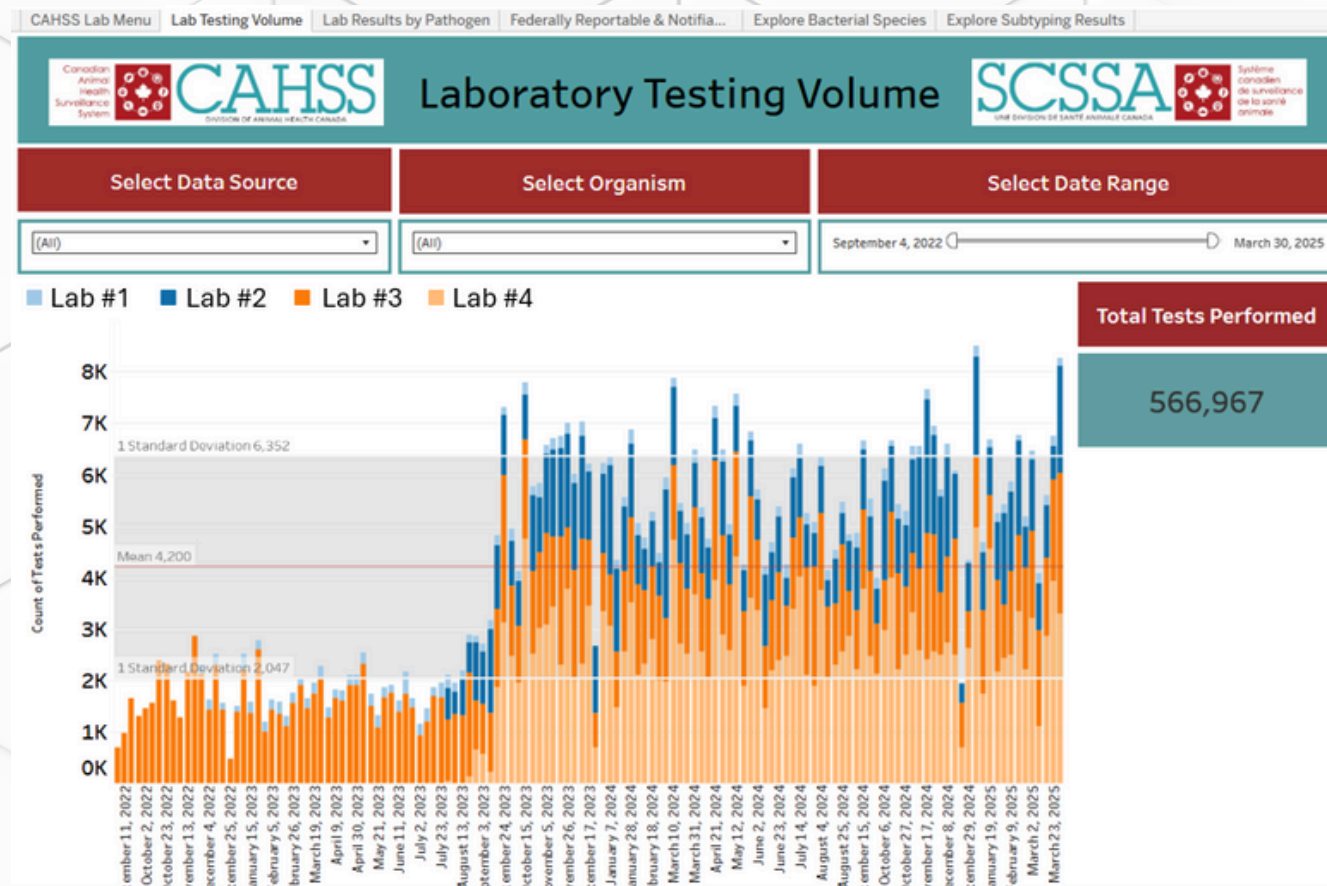

- Between May and June, the Western Canadian Animal Health Network (WeCAHN) conducted six network meetings for Q1 2025, fostering networking opportunities with the newly appointed WeCAHN coordinator.
