

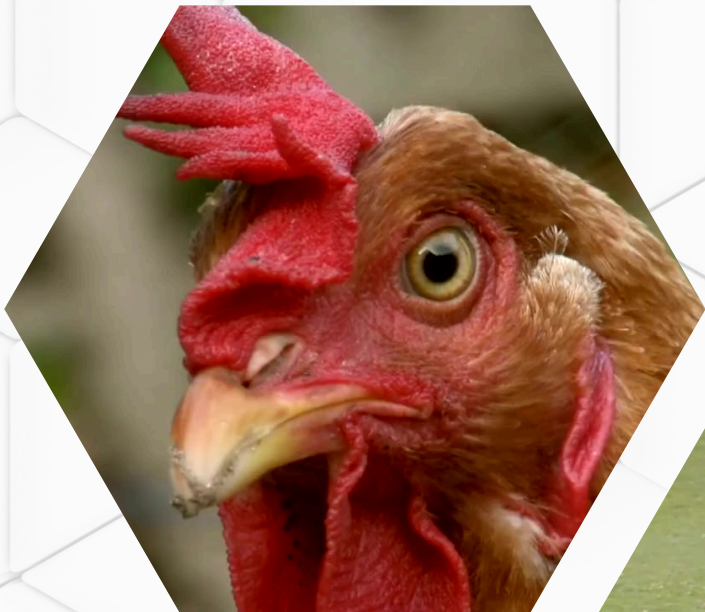

The CAHSS data platform has two data streams:

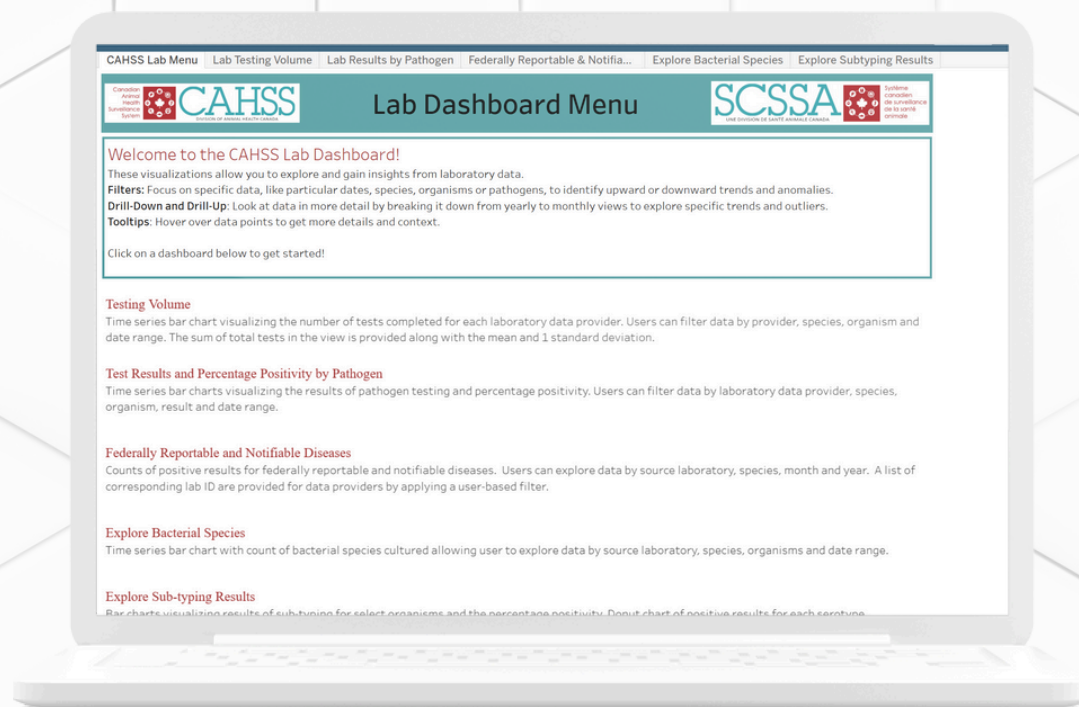

- Ontario Avian Influenza Cases and Resources 2025: In order to track Ontario avian influenza cases this year, OAHN has published a page to collect all relevant releases from stakeholders.
- The OAHN 2025 keynote speaker series included talks on HPAI in equids, H5N1 movement across North America, and the European avian metapneumovirus experience.
- The recent Swine network report included updates on H5N1 and H3N2 clade 2010.1, the PEDV and PDCoV report, and the international disease topics of interest summary.
- The recent Poultry network report included summaries from the clinical impressions surveys for Q4 2024, and the Animal Health Laboratory poultry pathology summary.
