Wildlife Network (Next Meeting: Nov 5)

- The CAHSS Wildlife Network advanced several national surveillance priorities, including expanding Chronic Wasting Disease risk assessment work across Canada and tracking emerging wildlife health concerns such as HPAI, rising raccoon rabies activity near the Ontario-Quebec border, White Nose Syndrome in the Northwest Territories, and Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease in Saskatchewan



Wildlife-Domestic Animal Interface Working Group (Next Meeting: Nov 12)

- The Wildlife-Domestic Animal Interface Working Group is transitioning to a project-driven model, with priorities including closing biosecurity and emergency preparedness gaps, developing proactive mitigation plans for threats such as HPAI and Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease, and strengthening coordination around emerging wildlife-livestock risks including wild pigs.
