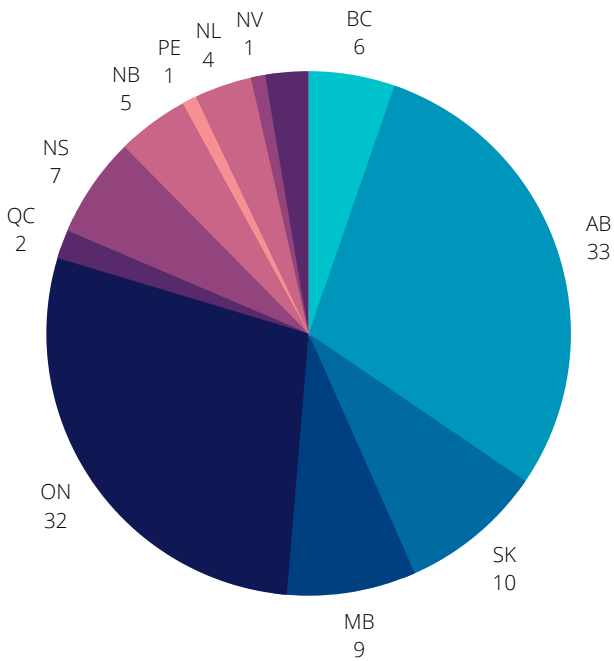

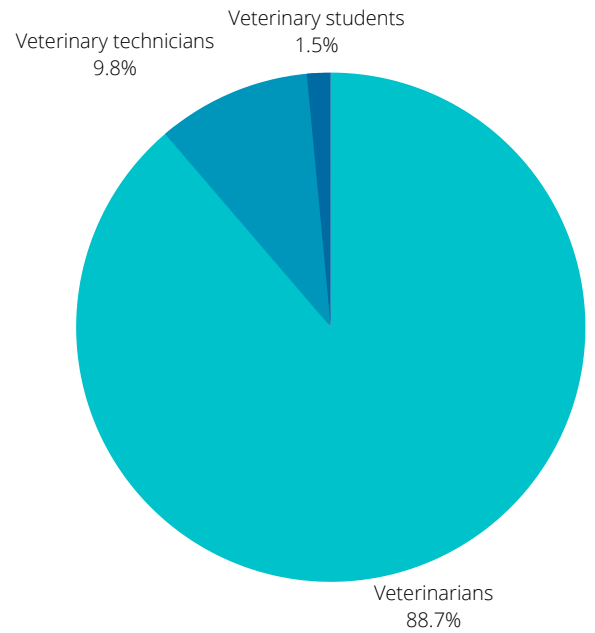
## SMALLHOLDER SWINE COURSE 2022 - STATS
