Bovine tuberculosis in Montana

Pathogen: Bacteria; Transmission: Aerosol, direct contact, ingestion; Species affected in event: Cattle

① Bovine TB has been confirmed in a Montana beef herd for the first time in decades. Bovine TB was confirmed in a Blaine County herd following the detection of the disease in a cow at a slaughter plant in Minnesota. Identification collected from the infected cow at the time of slaughter linked the animal to a Blaine County beef herd and subsequent herd testing revealed additional TB infected animals. The herd has been placed under quarantine. A full epidemiological investigation is underway.
