
## SUMMARY: RELEVANT EVENTS (includes all events rated ≥ 3.0)

#### **African Swine Fever**

- Germany has confirmed a total of 480 cases of ASF in wild boar; the National Reference Laboratory did not confirm ASF in a suspected case of a wild boar found in Potsdam
- India has reported new cases of ASF in multiple areas of the Imphal East district in Manipur and suspect that they are linked to illegal pig imports

#### **African Swine Fever in Europe**

Avrg. Rating: 2.0 - 3.0

- In Germany, the National Reference Laboratory did not confirm ASF in a suspected case in a wild boar in Potsdam, total wild boar case count is 480
- Ukraine has reported an outbreak of ASF in domestic swine
- Latvia has reported cases of ASF in wild boar

#### **African Swine Fever in Asia**

No. of weeks in report: 91

Avrg. Rating: 2.0 - 3.0

- India has reported new cases of ASF in multiple areas of the Imphal East district in Manipur and suspect that they are linked to illegal pig imports
- Vietnam has reported an outbreak of ASF in domestic swine
- South Korea continues to report cases of ASF in wild boar

## Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza in Asia

Avrg. Rating: 2.0 - 2.8

- Taiwan has reported that a wild duck has tested positive for HPAI H5 in the Aogu Wetlands Forest Park; they also have 3 other active events associated with HPAI H5N5, H5N2, and H5
- India has confirmed outbreaks of avian influenza across nine states with others still awaiting test results, samples have tested positive for H5N8 and H5N1

### COVID-19 Worldwide (as of January 10, 2021)

No. of Signals: 70

No. of weeks in report: 43

Avrg. Rating: 1.0 – 2.8

- Worldwide, there were 90,769,055 confirmed cases of COVID-19 with 1,944,726 deaths reported
- In Canada, the National Microbiology Laboratory has reported 660,289 cases of COVID-19 and 16,950 deaths: British Columbia (56,632 confirmed, 988 deaths), Alberta (111,452 confirmed, 1284 deaths), Saskatchewan (18,110 confirmed, 191 deaths), Manitoba (26,317 confirmed, 738 deaths), Ontario (215,782 confirmed, 4983 deaths), Quebec (228,821 confirmed, 8686 deaths), Newfoundland and Labrador (393 confirmed, 4 deaths), New Brunswick (779 confirmed, 9 deaths), Nova Scotia (1528 confirmed, 65 deaths), Prince Edward Island (102), Yukon (70 confirmed, 1 death), Northwest Territories (24), Nunavut (266 confirmed, 1 deaths), repatriated Canadians (13)
- Canada's first case of South African COVID-19 variant has been found in Alberta
- The operator of a second British Columbia mink farm where animals tested positive for SARS-CoV-2 has euthanized the remaining 1,000 mink
- Gorilla troop at the San Diego Zoo Safari Park has tested positive for SARS-CoV-2

### Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza in Europe

Avrg. Rating: 2.0 - 2.5

- Denmark has reported an outbreak of HPAI H5N8 in Jutland
- Sweden has reported an outbreak of HPAI H5N8 on a poultry farm in Skane Lan
- Lithuania has reported an outbreak of HPAI H5N8 in backyard poultry in Kaunas
- Slovakia has reported a case of HPAI H5N8 in a captive bird in a zoo in Kosice
- Germany is set to cull 62,000 turkeys and ducks after detecting additional outbreaks of HPAI H5N8
- Various strains of HPAI have also been detected in wild birds in: Slovenia, Belgium, Netherlands, Lithuania
