

# **Equine Herpes Virus-1 in Quebec**

Pathogen: Virus ; Transmission: Direct contact, Fomite; Species affected in event: Equine

① Equine herpesvirus myeloencephalitis has caused the deaths of 2 horses and infected nearly half of the other 39 animals housed in stables at the Luskville farm, in Quebec. Another case of a positive horse from Outauais Region, Quebec, has also been reported but it is not clear if this horse is part of the same outbreak or a separate outbreak in a different farm suggesting spread in the region. # Salmonella linked to pet turtles in the US

Pathogen: Bacteria; Transmission: Direct contact, Fomite; Species affected in event: Human

① CDC and public health officials in several states are investigating a multistate outbreak of Salmonella Typhimurium infections linked to small turtles. As of 20 Feb 2021, a total of 22 people infected with the outbreak strain of Salmonella Typhimurium have been reported from 7 states. Illnesses started on dates ranging from 27 Aug 2020 to 16 Jan 2021. Read More
