



① The CIUSSS de l'Estrie – CHUS is warning the public of an unusually high concentration of anaplasmosis in the Eastern Townships. Specifically, the regional public health department has logged six cases in the Bromont area, representing the first cluster of this kind in Quebec.

Bovine Tuberculosis in Israel

Pathogen: Bacteria; Transmission: Direct contact, fomite; Species affected in event: Deer

① Spotted deer from Hamat Gader have been found tuberculosis positive in 5 rural school zoos throughout northern Israel. This is in addition to the first outbreak detected in Kiryat Motzkin. In some of the affected locations, dairy cattle operations are maintained. About 75% of the deer originating in Hamat Gader have been found infected. Read More
