





① Nepal has reported its first outbreaks of Glanders to the OIE. Two outbreaks occurred in November 2020 in the provinces of Lumbini and Bagmati Pradesh, affecting 4-5 years old mules and horses.

- ASF continues to wreak havoc in Mizoram, killing 4,650 pigs and piglets in a little over two months
- The Philippines have reported a case of ASF in wild boar in Abra province
