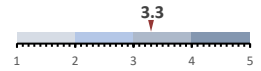

① Nepal has reported its first outbreaks of Glanders to the OIE. Two outbreaks occurred in November 2020 in the provinces of Lumbini and Bagmati Pradesh, affecting 4-5 years old mules and horses.
