Pathogen: Prion ; Transmission: Atypical ; Species affected in event: Cattle

Brazil, the world's largest beef exporter, has suspended beef exports to China after confirming two cases of atypical BSE in two separate domestic meat plants. The cases were identified in meat plants in the states of Mato Grosso and Minas Gerais. They are the fourth and fifth cases of atypical BSE that have been detected in Brazil in 23 years.
