COVID-19 Worldwide (as of December 6, 2020)

- Worldwide, there were 67,493,598 confirmed cases of COVID-19 with 1,543,629 deaths reported
- In <u>Canada</u>, the National Microbiology Laboratory has reported 415,182 cases of COVID-19 and 12,665 deaths: British Columbia (36,132 confirmed, 492 deaths), Alberta (68,566 confirmed, 615 deaths), Saskatchewan (10,139 confirmed, 59 deaths), Manitoba (18,806 confirmed, 395 deaths), Ontario (127,309 confirmed, 3772 deaths), Quebec (151,599 confirmed, 7255 deaths), Newfoundland and Labrador (351 confirmed, 4 deaths), New Brunswick (534 confirmed, 7 deaths), Nova Scotia (1368 confirmed, 65 deaths), Prince Edward Island (80), Yukon (45 confirmed, 1 death), Northwest Territories (15), Nunavut (216), repatriated Canadians (13)

- Germany has reported another HPAI H5N8 outbreak, this time at a layer farm with 28,500 chickens in Mecklenburg-Vorpommern
- Spain and Sweden have detected HPAI H5N8 in wild birds
