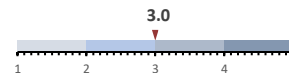

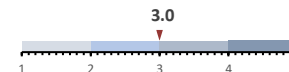

### Newcastle Disease virus in Spain

**Pathogen:** virus; **Transmission:** direct contact, fomite, aerosol; **Species affected in event:** poultry

① Spain has reported four outbreaks of Newcastle Disease virus in the Valencia region. This is the first time the virus has been detected in Spain since 2022, when outbreaks were reported in the Almeria region. The first outbreak was confirmed at a broiler farm in Llutxent, housing ~15,000 birds. Shortly thereafter, three additional outbreaks were identified within the protection zone and involved >65,000 birds. Preliminary investigations indicate a direct epidemiological link between the initial case and the subsequent outbreaks.

### New World Screwworm in Central America & Mexico

- [Mexico](#) has reported its first case of NWS in Michoacan
- As of January 7, 2026, [Mexico](#) is reporting 492 active cases of NWS, with 13,335 accumulated cases (since November 4, 2024)
- [Mexico](#) has also reported additional human cases of NWS infestation, bringing the total number to 110 (Chiapas = 87, Campeche = 4, Tabasco = 2, Yucatan = 8, Oaxaca = 3, Quintana Roo = 5, Veracruz = 1)

- Over the last week, the [USDA](#) has reported outbreaks of HPAI in commercial poultry in: Kansas(1) and North Carolina(1); in WOAHP poultry in: Missouri(1), Indiana(1), and Kansas(1); in WOAHP non-poultry in: North Dakota(1), North Carolina(1), Missouri(1), Illinois(1), Wyoming(1), Kansas(1), Texas(1), Oklahoma(1), California(1), Colorado(1), and Oregon(1); and in live-bird markets in: Pennsylvania(2)
- As of January 12, 2026, the [USDA](#) has reported influenza A (H5N1) in 1084 dairy herds across 19 states: Wisconsin(1), Nebraska(1), Wyoming(1), North Carolina(1), Ohio(1), Oklahoma(2), Kansas(4), Arizona(5), South Dakota(7), [Minnesota](#)(9), New Mexico(9), Nevada(11), Iowa(13), Utah(13), Texas(30), [Michigan](#)(31), [Colorado](#)(64), Idaho(108), and California(773); no new outbreaks were reported in the last two weeks
- As of December 31, 2025, [California](#) has four (4) dairy herds under quarantine for H5N1 influenza infection, including one (1) herd that was re-quarantined following a new detection on a previously cleared premises
- [Florida](#) has confirmed that 21 birds (including 19 royal mute swans) discovered dead near Lake Eola in December died from HPAI

### African Swine Fever in Europe

Avg. Rating: 2.0 – 2.4

- [Spain](#) has reported 18 additional cases of ASF in wild boar, bringing the total count to 50; more than 620 boars have been analyzed in recent weeks, with around 8% testing positive for the virus
- [Moldova](#) has reported cases of ASF in domestic swine
- [Bulgaria](#) and [Moldova](#) have also reported cases of ASF in wild boar

### Lumpy Skin Disease in Europe

Avg. Rating: 2.4

- [France](#) has reported an additional outbreak of LSD in Ariège, bringing the total number of outbreaks in the country to 117
- [Spain](#) and [Italy](#) have not reported any additional outbreaks of LSD since October/November 2025
